Because of a faulty pistol, fully-automatic timings were not obtainable, but the camera was operated with manually started timer. This enables differentials to be compared with the manual returns, and a few adjustments are called for. These are listed here-under, down to N.U.T.S. standards.

Modus operandi. The normal method of working (i.e. assuming the winning time is correct and adding differentials to obtain the remainder) is far from ideal, since there is clearly a good chance that the winning time might be wrong and all the others correct. In some cases, therefore, the winning time has to be adjusted. The 400m Hurdles heats give a clear example of the method used:

There is a differential of 0.09 between 1st and 2nd, but it is not possible to guarantee whether the winner should be 55.6 or the second should be 55.8; in fact, as the "presumed range" shows, both could have been true 55.7's on round-off. The remaining figures also show fluctuations either up or down, but in all cases bar one they lie within the presumed range and it is not possible to point to a consistent trend. The exception is 5th place, which on this evidence should be adjusted to 57.5.
